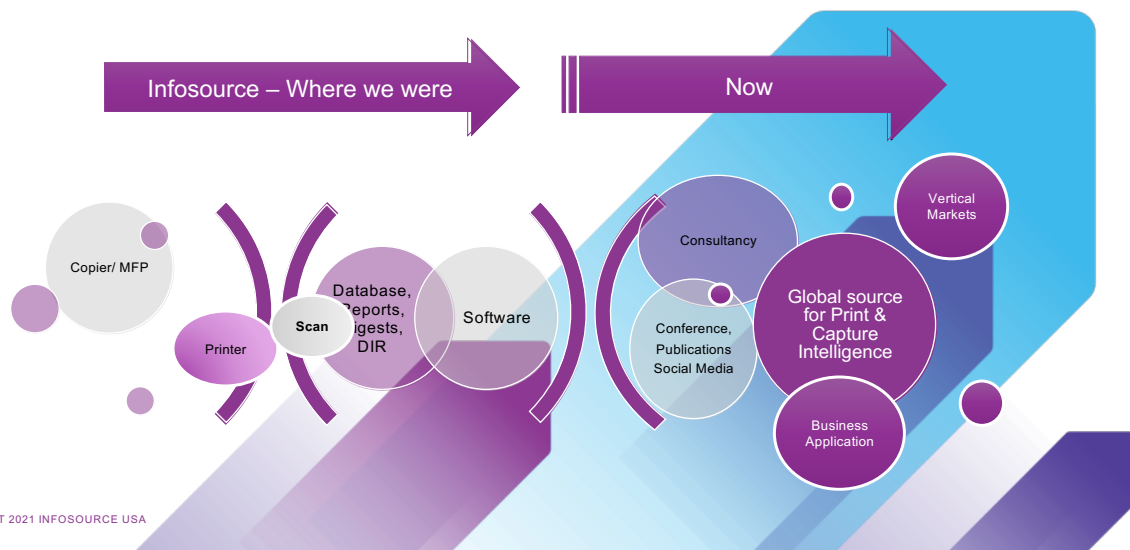

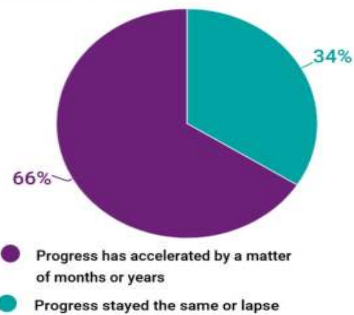
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THE PANDEMIC DROVE A TRANSITION TO DIGITAL PROCESSES

The creation of a new workforce model, with human workers augmented by automation and artificial intelligence



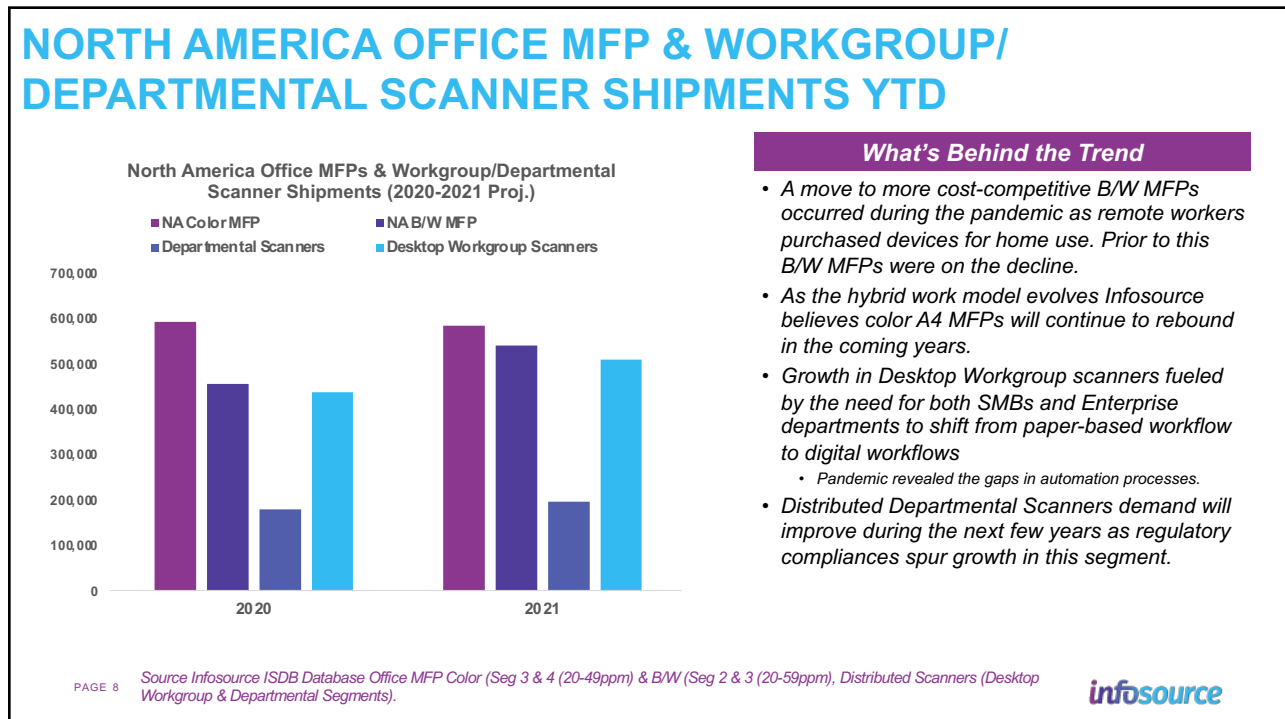
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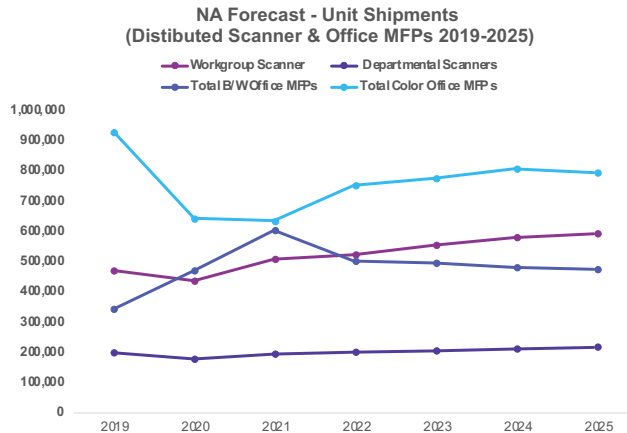
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NORTH AMERICA DISTRIBUTED SCANNER & OFFICE MFP MARKET FORECAST (2021-2025)

Distributed Scanner Segments –Workgroup & Departmental, Office MFPs – (B/W & Color)



What's Behind the Trend

- Total Office Color MFPs forecasted to grow at a 1.4% CAGR thru 2025.
 - Bright spot is Color A4 MFPs (30-49ppm & 50+ppm)
- While Office B/W MFPs expected to decline at a 1.3% CAGR.
 - Shift to color is not enough to bring back pre-pandemic unit volumes.
 - Acceleration to digital workflow is happening at a faster pace due to the pandemic.
- Desktop Workgroup Scanners are expected to grow at a 3.2% CAGR thru 2025.
- Infosource is forecasting Departmental scanners to grow at a 2.0% CAGR thru 2025.
 - U.S. FADGI Initiative & Security compliances fueling digitization growth in departmental scanners.

MARKET OPPORTUNITY

More Electronic Input, but Majority is still documents

- Leverage existing MFP scanning capability – on-ramp for digital workflow expansion
- Majority of office MFPs scan utilization is scan to desktop, scan to email, scan to cloud app.
- PDF is fastest growing source for electronic input
- New “network” scanners offer smart connected cloud solutions for seamless integration into ECM systems.
 - Xerox/Visioneer D70n (TWAIN Direct Scanner)
 - Fujitsu fi-7300NX
 - Kodak Alaris Infuse AX

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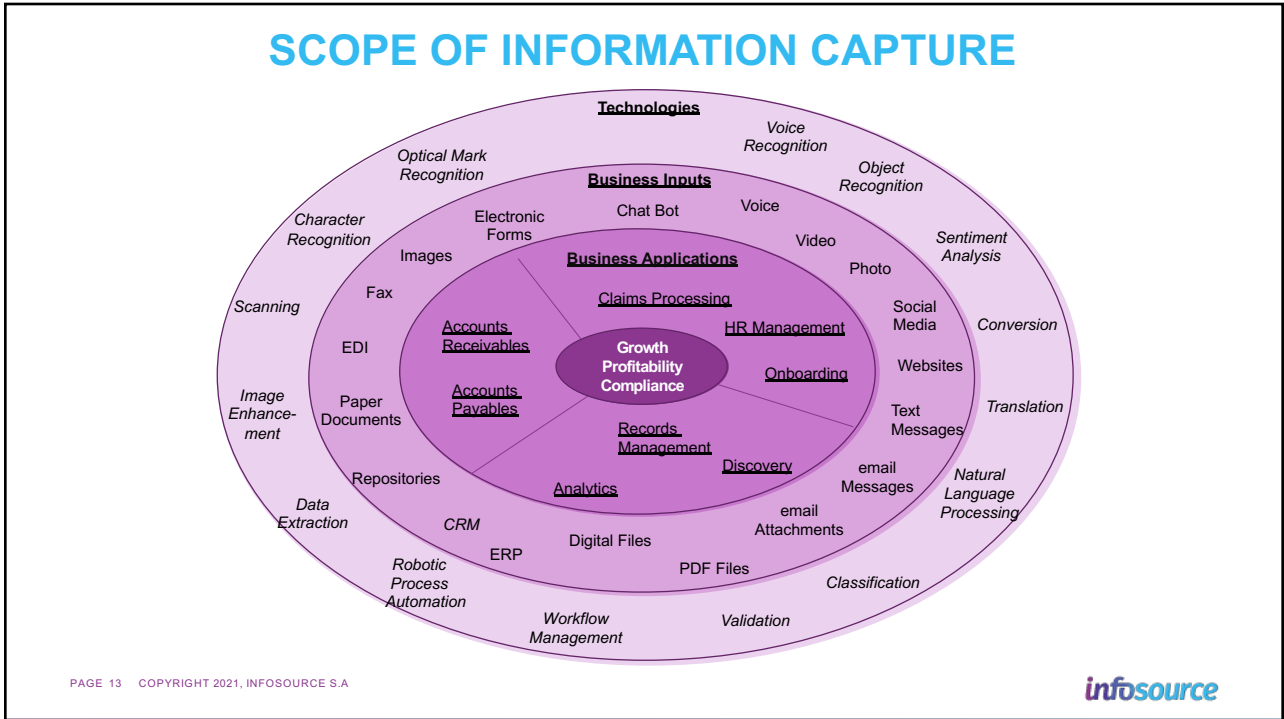

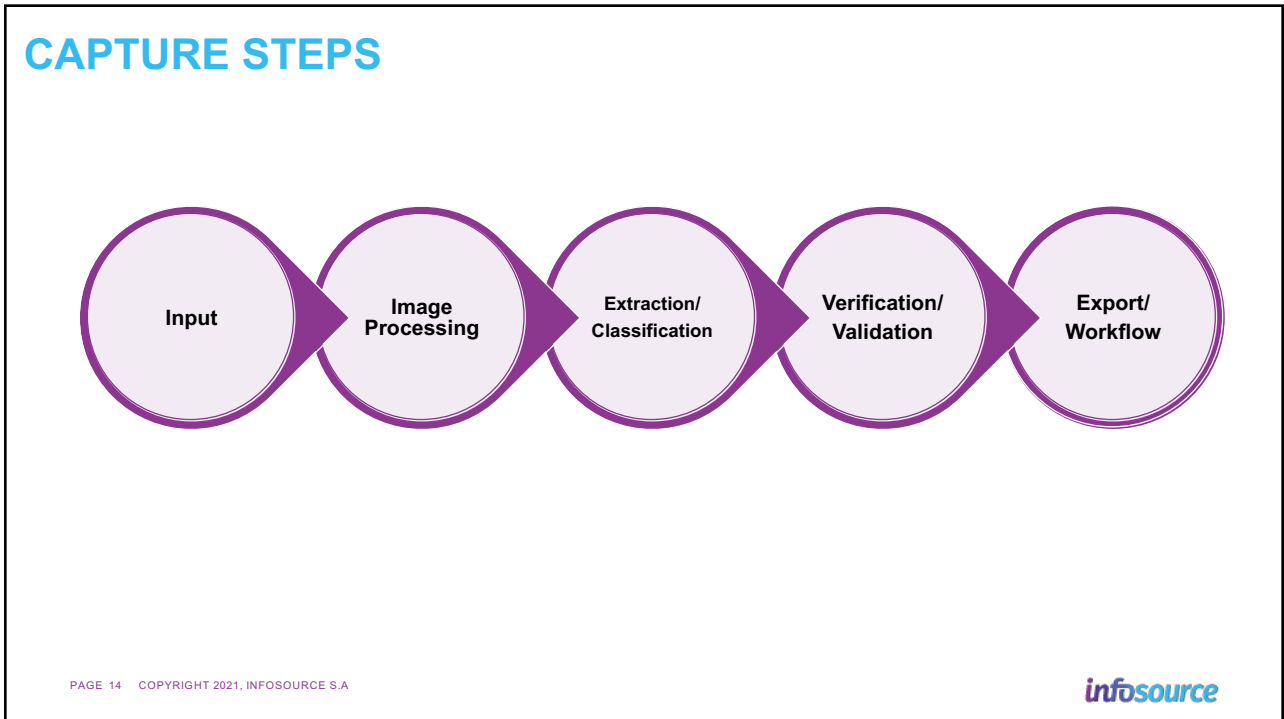
Terminology used by Infosource

- Capture Software includes solutions and services used to process business inputs.
- It acquires, classifies, and converts unstructured and semi-structured information into enhanced usable data for use in business transactions, analytics, records management, discovery, and compliance applications.
- Worth \$2B in NA 2020, with projected CAGR of 6%, 2020-2025

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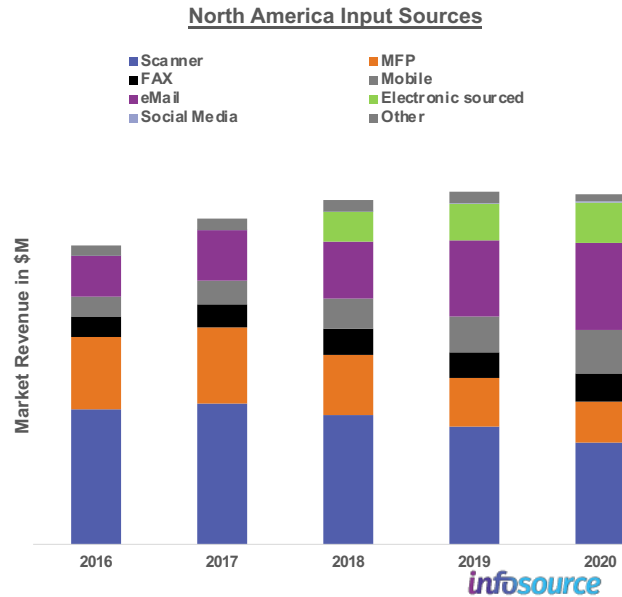
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IMPORTANT INPUT CONSIDERATIONS

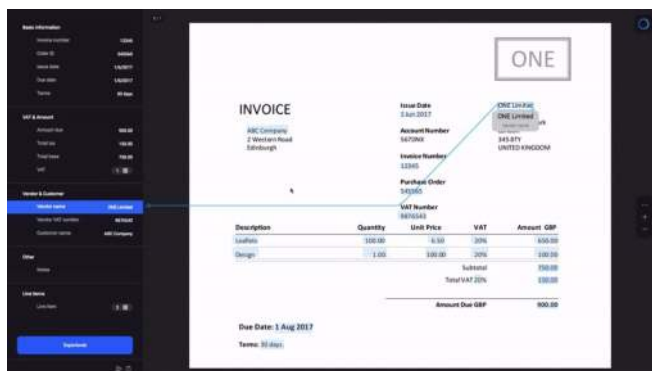
- Do you have standard or mixed types of documents?
- Scanning paper is a commodity
- Network Scanning emerging as wave of future
 - Direct integration to interface
 - Watched folder
- Need to Handle increasing volume of electronic input
- Fax is not dead
- Have to account for mobile
- Opportunity for backfile conversion?



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CONSIDERATIONS FOR EXTRACTION & CLASSIFICATION



- What kind of documents do you have?
 - Structured forms
 - Semi-structured like invoices
 - unstructured - contracts
- OCR vs. AI/Machine Learning
- Auto vs. Manual Classification
- SDK vs. out-of-box
- Cloud vs. on-prem

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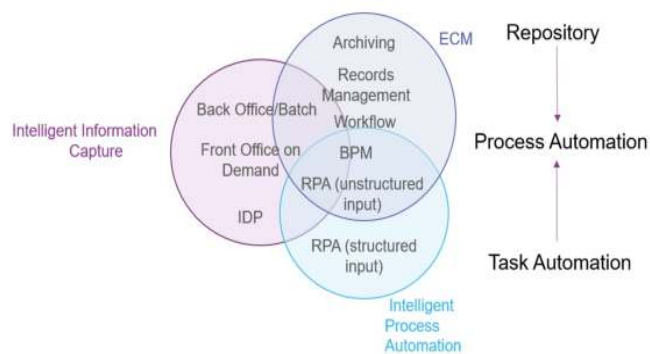
CONSIDERATION FOR VERIFICATION/VALIDATION

- What is your footprint of data verification personnel?
 - Dedicated capture team or knowledge workers
 - Distributed, on-prem, hybrid
 - Is outsourcing in play?
- What is confidence level threshold?
 - Cost of false positives vs. cost of adding extra steps for verification
 - Are there any regulations in play?
- Is there another data source that can be leveraged to check against?
 - Line of business systems
 - Third-party data sets

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EXPORT AND WORKFLOW CONSIDERATIONS

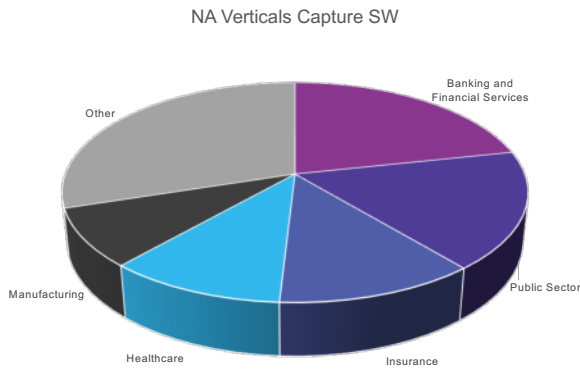
The Intersection of Capture, BPM and RPA

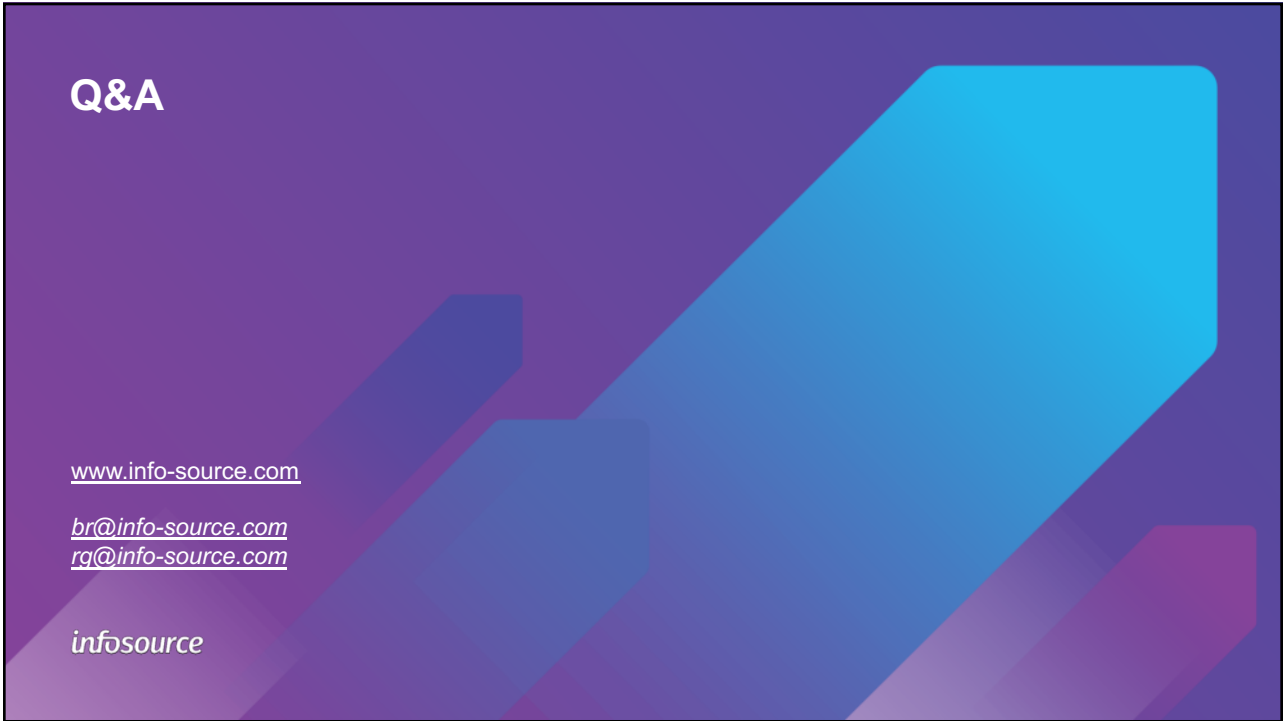

| Invoice Processing example | | Scanning of invoices, manual keying of data | Automated data extraction and validation vs. accounting systems | Extract from email, automated capture plus approval and exception processes | Fully automated order to cash from purchase requisition to payment |
