Who is Eligible?

Applicants must be (at the time of the evaluation and the award):

• A full-time U.S. military veteran employee of a current BTA member dealership or his (or her) child or grandchild.

AND

• A full-time student maintaining a class schedule of at least 12 hours (nine hours for graduate students) of college credits per semester throughout the school year covered by the scholarship at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or technical/trade school.

Evaluation Information

- Patriot Pack applications are evaluated separately from BTA scholarship applications.
- Applications are evaluated by an independent and impartial evaluator.
- Winners are determined based on several factors, including: GPA; school activities; leadership positions; work experience, recognition and awards; community involvement; and an essay.
- Scholarships are not based on financial need.
- · Applications are due by May 1, 2026.
