Scholarships for use at colleges or accredited vocational trade schools are available to the full-time employees of current BTA member dealerships and their children.

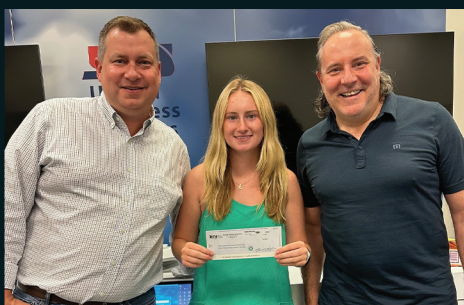
